COMMON SCAMS TO AVOID

Government Impersonation: The scammer will contact you over the phone and say that they are a member of a government agency or law enforcement, calling about a situation. They may tell you that a car you have registered was found at a crime scene, and you may be arrested if you don't comply.

Romance Scams: Scammers will try to take advantage of people looking for love using online dating websites or social media. The scammer will create a fake persona, gain your trust, and then ask for money to fix a car or to make ends meet for the month.

Grandparent Scams: In an attempt to tug on heartstrings, the scammers may call over the phone pretending to be a family member or a law enforcement officer claiming that a grandchild is in trouble. The scammer will claim that they need money wired as soon as possible.

Post Office Employees' Credit Union (POECU) is pleased to announce the winner of the 2022 Guy C. Comes \$1,000 Memorial Scholarship—Jude Edwards. Jude is the son of Scott and Leslie Edwards. He is a 2022 graduate of Brother Martin High School (BMHS) in New Orleans.

Mr. Edwards was in the top 10% of his graduating class with a grade point average of 4.4038. He served as Captain of the Tennis Team, was a Student Ambassador, and member of the National Honor Society, National Society of High School Scholars, Excalibur National Honor Society in Science and Mu Alpha Theta. He also received the National African American Recognition Award for academic excellence.

Jude also donated his time to Second Harvest Food Bank, Brother Martin's Tennis Camp, and to United States Tennis Association's (USTA's) Southern Chapter.
